All Ordeals could continue until after 10 pm on Saturday evening and other activities could continue through Sunday morning at the Spring and Fall Ordeals. Those parents who have concerns about the Ordeal ceremonies must contact the Lodge Adviser prior to the Ordeal. As per National guidelines concerning non-members witnessing the ceremonies, other than parents and guardians, no other non-members will be allowed to view the ceremonies or near the ceremony site, i.e. siblings or family friends. Parents wanting to view the ceremony will be required to attend a briefing. It should be noted that the hike to the ceremony sites are rough and strenuous. Those who must leave for family or religious reasons on Saturday evening will be expected to stay until the end of the Ordeal which could last until 10 pm. Non-Arrowmen family members are not to arrive at camp prior to 4 pm on Saturday.

- DINNER FEE** \$15.00 – For guests attending only the Saturday evening meal.
- LATE FEE** (per person) \$10.00 – For everyone registering after the noon deadline on Friday prior to the ordeal.
